

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BURPEE AND MILLS**

**By-law No 07 - 2016**

Being a By-law to provide for the adoption of tax rates and to further provide for penalty and interest in default of payment thereof for 2016

**WHEREAS** the Municipal Act, Chapter 25, R.S.O. 2001, provides that the Council of a local municipality shall after the adoption of estimates for the year pass a by-law to levy a tax rate on the whole of the assessment for real property or other assessments made under the Assessment Act according to the amounts assessed and or not upon one or more kinds of property or assessment or in different proportions, and,

**WHEREAS** the said Act require tax rates to be established in the same proportion to tax ratios; and whereas council has set tax ratios by By-law 08 - 2012 and will continue to use this established rate.

**WHEREAS** certain education rates are provided in various regulations and amounts have been requisitioned by the Province,

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Burpee and Mills enacts as follows:

- 1 **THAT** the tax rates for 2016 for municipal and education purposes be hereby set as follows:

Class	Municipal rate	Education rate	Total Rate
Residential/Farm	0.009732	0.00188	0.011612
Commercial Occupied	0.01139	0.00483067	0.01622067
Farmlands	0.002433	0.00047	0.002903
Managed Forest	0.002433	0.00047	0.002903
Industrial	0.01139	0.0118	0.02319

2. **THAT** all taxes shall become due and payable in ONE instalment as follows: 100% of the final levy shall become due and payable on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of August, 2016.
3. **Non-payment** of the amount, as noted, on the dates stated in accordance with this by-law constitutes default. On all taxes of the levy which are in default after the noted due dates shall be added a penalty of 1.25% per month, until December 31, 2016.
4. **On all taxes unpaid** as of December 31, 2016 interest shall be added at the rate of 1.25% per month, for each month or fraction thereof in, which the arrears continue.
5. **All taxes** are due and payable by cheque, cash or money order to the Township of Burpee and Mills at the municipal office.

**Read a first and second time** this 6 day of July 2016.

**Read a third and final time** this 6 day of July 2016.
