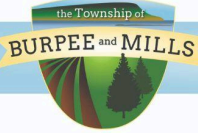

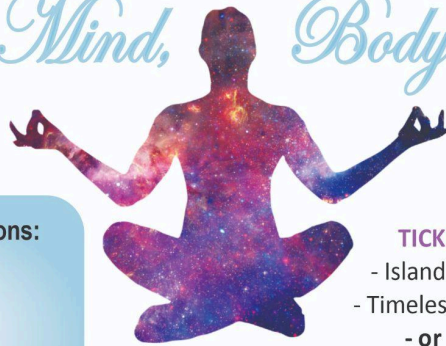

Fire Safety **Grass fires are not permitted in the Township of Burpee and Mills!!** Fire permits are required for all burning but at no time is burning grass allowed. Be very cautious when having any fire. Always have a garden hose, water pail, shovel, or other fire suppression tools handy.
