Fire Safety **Grass fires are not permitted in the Township of Burpee and Mills!!** Fire permits are required for all burning but at no time is burning grass allowed. Be very cautious when having any fire. Always have a garden hose, water pail, shovel, or other fire suppression tools handy. Burning without a permit can lead to a fine and if the fire gets away on you, you may be charged with the cost of the fire call out.

It's been very wet lately, but caution when burning is never a bad idea.
